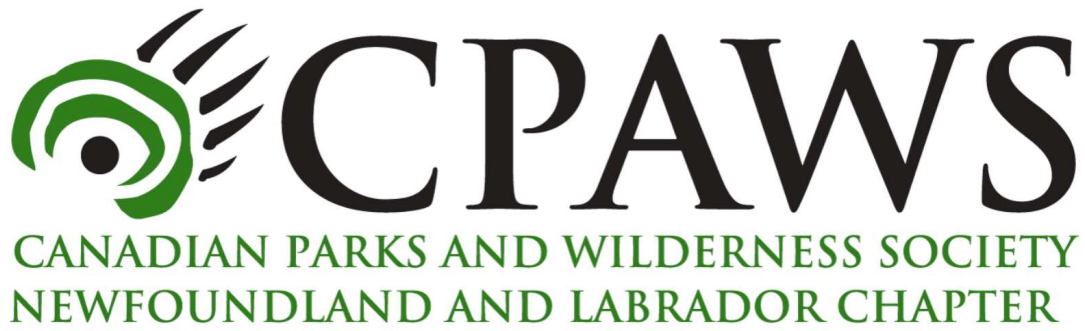

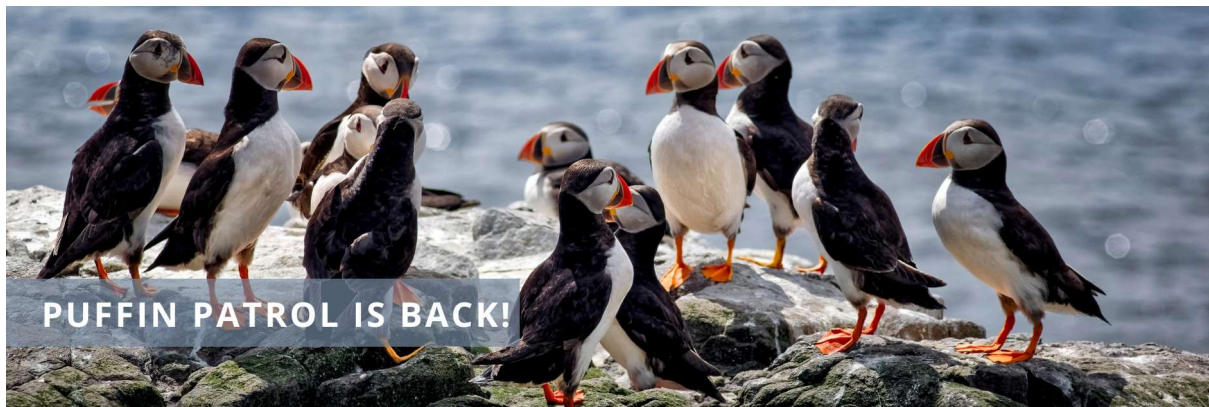

Local residents from Bay Bulls, Witless Bay, Mobile, Tors Cove, Burnt Cove, St. Michael's and Bauline **do not need to register**.

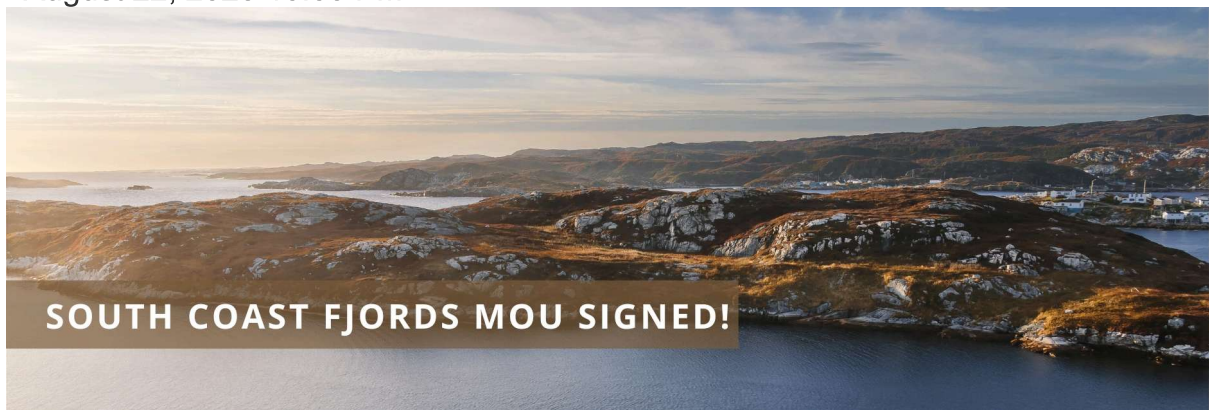
- Once registered, please fill out your waivers before your patrol date! Waiver links will be shared with the registration confirmation and on the event page.

On the 23rd of June, delegates of the Miawpukek First Nation, Qalipu First Nation, the Town of Burgeo, and the Government of Newfoundland met alongside Parks Canada to sign an agreement to work together on a proposal for a National Marine Conservation Area in the South Coast Fjords of Newfoundland. This landmark agreement solidified their collaboration in crafting a proposal for a national marine conservation area within the South Coast Fjords of Newfoundland.
